

Projecting Signs

Maximum of 3 feet wide and sign can not be mounted more than 6 inches from the building

No Higher Than the Bottom of the second story window

THIS IS 8 INCH HIGH LETTERING ON THIS SIGN

- Current standards for projecting signs allow 12 inch lettering on an maximum 6 square foot sign. Shown is 8 inch high lettering. Consider allowing signs to be a maximum of 12 square feet (maximum of 4 feet wide) but with 8 inch high lettering where the first letter of each word can be 12 inches high. This lets the type have some room to breath and make it easier to read.



Current sign standards don't allow having a projecting sign and a wall sign as shown above. Consider revising this to allow such a combination.
